What am I entitled to when I sign up?

- 1-year unlimited access to all classes in the package
- Library of practice tests with detailed score reports

What do you mean by unlimited access to classes?

You can attend and repeat any classes for a 1-year period after signing up.

Can I repeat classes?

You can repeat classes, but the material taught will be the same – students do this as a revision before re-taking the exam or to review any content that they may have missed.

The Advanced classes will review the latest SAT papers released, so content may be different.

Are classes online or offline?

Classes are held concurrently online and offline, so you can attend whichever is most convenient for you.

Do I need to do a diagnostic test?

We strongly recommend doing a free diagnostic test first to understand your strengths and weaknesses, so that we can help identify which preparation program will be most efficient for you.

Which batch should I come for?

You can start at any time, even in the middle of a batch, and make up classes that you have missed in future batches.

Do I need to go to Core 1 before Core 2, Core 2 before 3, etc?

You can take classes in any order, though we recommend that you take the review classes (core 5 and 9) last.

Do I need to let you know before I come for class?

No – you can come at any time that works for you.

How many practice tests can I do?

You will have unlimited access to the IvyPrep test library. However, it is important to space out to ensure appropriate time for review.
